What is a paragraph?

In an academic essay, a body paragraph is a block of sentences that develops only ONE idea; each body paragraph develops a point signaled in your thesis statement as presented in the list below:

Topic Senter —announce	nce * es the main idea of the paragraph
Evidential S	Sentences elevant evidence that establishes context for your topic
and is usual	
Analytical S	entences
—explain e	vidence in context of your thesis
Concluding	Sentence
—restates t	he main idea and may include a transition to the next topic



^{*} You may want to include transitional words and phrases, such as in addition, moreover, or evidently with your topic sentence to assure a better flow between paragraphs. However, do not forget the main purpose of a topic sentence - to announce the main idea of the paragraph. Example

Thesis Statement Even though opponents of pizza allege that it is fattening, messy, and low-quality, pizza should be praised for its affordability and cultural adaptability.

Topic Sentence	First, pizza is one of the most affordable foods available: it can cost as little as \$1 per slice. A
Evidential Sentence(s)	researcher at the Institute of Nutrition Studies, Alicia Jalowsky shows that the average fast food
	burger costs about \$7, while a complete pizza meal with a drink costs about \$2.75 (39).
Analytical Sentence(s)	This is a standout bargain, even when compared to other cheap options. A person can
	feed a family of four with one large pizza for less than \$20.
Concluding Sentence	New Yorkers seeking an affordable meal know they can always turn to pizza.

Topic Sentence	Equally important, pizza has also evolved to reflect different cultures.	
Evidential Sentence(s)	In History of Italian Cuisine: A Fresh Cut, Sallucci emphasizes that the classic Margherita	
	pizza was created to honor Queen Margherita of Italy (223). Moreover, the same	
	author points out that its red tomato sauce, green basil, and white cheese	
	correspond to the colors of the stripes on the Italian flag (226).	
Analytical Sentence(s)	By reflecting different cultures through various ingredients and presentation, the consumers	
	feel a deeper, cultural connection with their communities through pizza.	
Concluding Sentence	Clearly, there is no universally correct way to enjoy a pizza.
