## **General guidance:**

- **LIBERAL ARTS:** Students must select courses from the list specified on the curriculum matrix; Transfer students should work with Ms. Shuman to determine if all of their liberal arts have transferred.
- **ENGR 101:** All students (freshman and transfers) who have not taken ENGR 101 must take CE 59901 in the fall (replaces ENGR 101)
- **HOLDS:** CUNY First will not allow students with any holds to register.
- **PROBATION:** Students who are on probation must meet with Ms. Shuman after their grades are posted. to review their contract; since this prevents them from registering ontime, they should plan to complete the CE online overtally when it opens a few days after grades are due (they will be sent an email reminder) to request seats in any CE courses that are already closed.
- **GRAD CHECKS:** After students complete 90 credits, they should request a grad check from Ms. Shuman to assess their progress towards graduation and identify any issues before they delay the student's graduation date.
