### **General Information**

Environmental Health and Occupational Safety (EHOS) offers monthly safety training sessions as required for all lab personnel (but not limited to): principal investigators, laboratory technicians, graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, researchers or any visiting personnel working in a lab. It is MANDATORY that any individual who has not received initial training MUST attend EHOS safety training, BEFORE working in a lab on campus. ## Fire Safety: Certificate of Fitness C-14

The City of New York Fire Department requires that all non-production chemical laboratories have a Certificate of Fitness for Non-Production Chemical Laboratories (C-14) holder to be present at all times during operation. The certificate is site specific to the City College campus and for the respective certificate holder. City College requires C-14 training to be completed once, as long as renewals of the certificates are maintained. #### **OSHA Lab Safety Standard**

This training includes information on lab standards and regulations set forth by OSHA. It includes potential hazards associated with the lab environment, along with applicable exposure control measures. City College requires the training to be completed every three years.

### **Hazardous Waste Management**

Hazardous Waste Management (HazWaste) Training includes information pertaining to EPA regulations governing proper disposal of waste generated during research or experiments. City College requires this training to be completed annually as per EPA regulations.
