DegreeWorks is a web-based program that enables you to easily track your academic progress. You will be able to see how specific College requirements have been met and what courses you can take to fulfill the requirements which are remaining.

## Tips:

- Use Firefox. It is the only browser that truly works.
- Check your degree works regularly:
  - Prior to and after each semester
  - After each enrollment
- If something doesn't look right, bring it up with an advisor right away. Errors can have severe results on your academic progress and/or financial aid eligibility.
- Bring a printout of your Worksheet to each advising session.
- Check to see if you have any classes listed as "Non-contributory". If so, speak to your advisor right away.

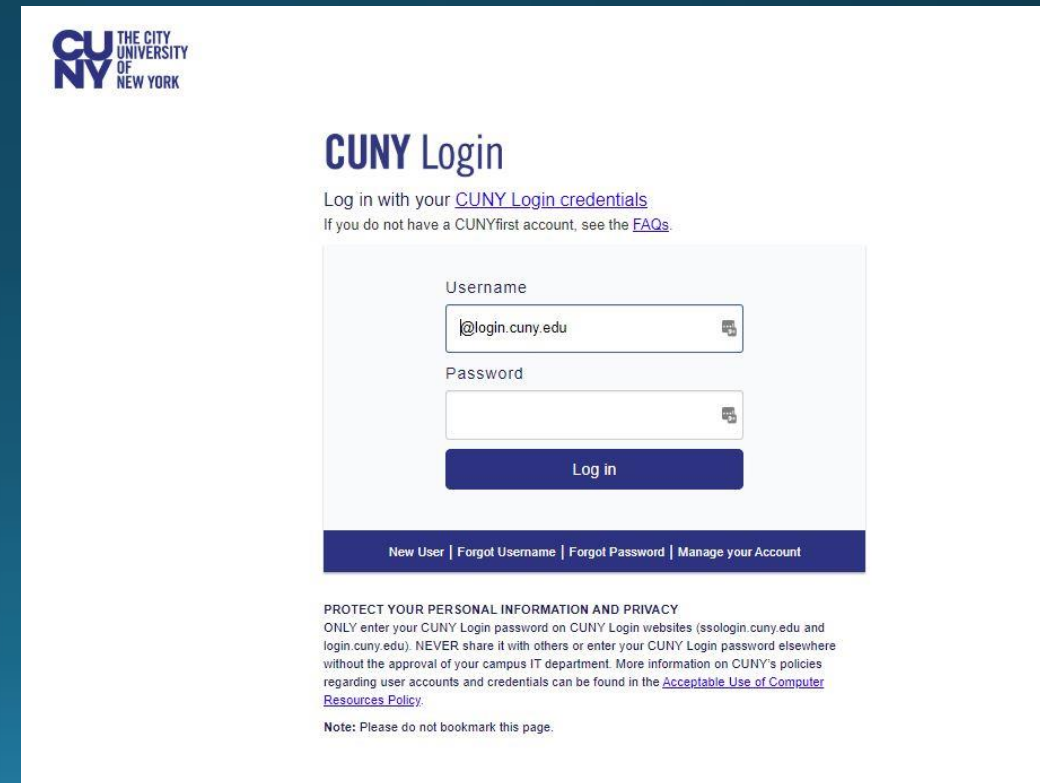
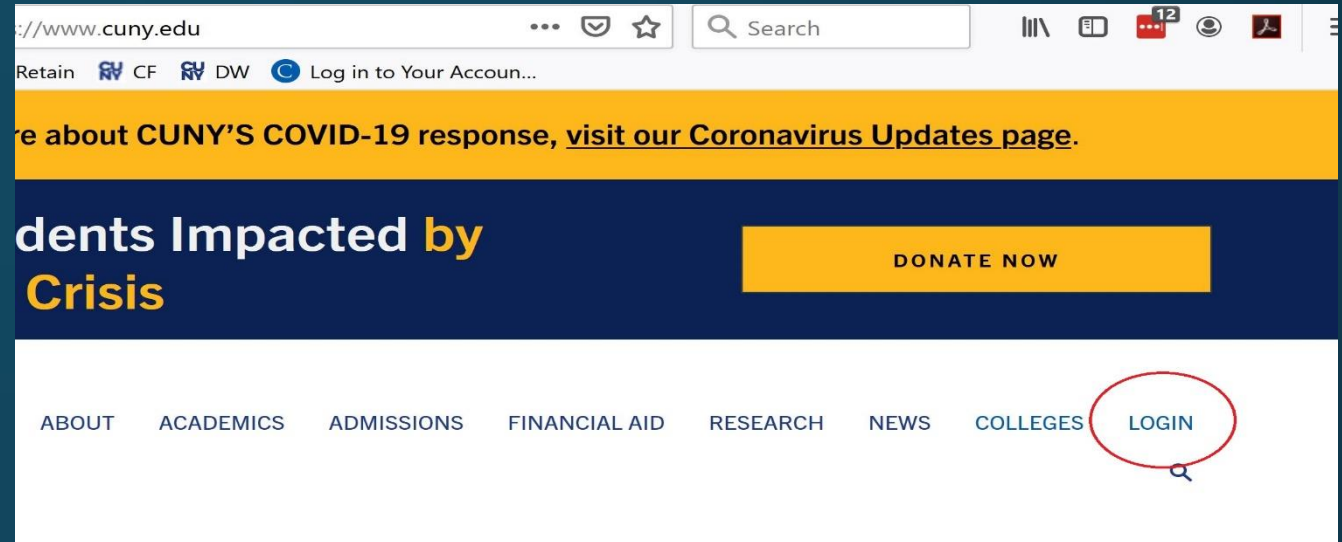
