Spring 2022 Civil Engineering Awards and Scholarships for Undergraduates Application Guidelines

Awards are available every semester. Students may apply in both the Fall and Spring semesters, and in multiple years, provided that they meet the eligibility criteria each time they apply. By submitting one application, students will be considered for all available awards at the time of their application.

WHO MAY APPLY

At a minimum, applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate CE student at CCNY,
- Have successfully completed three or more CE courses (completed at least 9 CE credits),
- Have a minimum GPA for CE courses of 2.7, and
- Not be planning to graduate at the end of the current semester.

Some awards have additional or more stringent criteria (see website). Macaulay Honors College students may not be eligible and should check with their Macaulay advisor before applying.

SELECTION OF AWARDEES

Applicants who meet the eligibility criteria and who submit a complete application will be seriously considered. Awards will be granted based on the criteria defined by the donors. In cases where no additional criteria are given, awards will be granted based on academic performance, service to the CE Department and the school, and need, and in that order.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF AWARDEES

All awardees are expected to attend the annual Civil Engineering Student-Faculty mixer to receive their award, and to write a thank you letter to the donor to be delivered in person to Prof. Feng-Bao Lin. Awardees may also be expected to attend a dinner function.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply, complete the application materials described below and submit by email to Prof. Feng-Bao Lin at <u>fblin@ccny.cuny.edu</u> <u>by Monday, February 28, 2022</u>. Applications that do not include all three of the items given below or are otherwise incomplete <u>will not be</u> considered (examples: form is not filled out completely or essay does not addressing all required points).

Application materials:

1) The completed form (next page)

2) A typed 500-word essay without grammar or spelling mistakes that clearly details the student's:

- Plans immediately after graduation and long-term goals (to be considered for the DFI and Moles awards, goals should relate to construction engineering/management),
- Service to the department,
- Need for financial support relative to the current amount of support indicated on the form (provide dollar amounts of income and expenses to justify need), and
- Any past awards received from the CE department and when they were received.

3) A current transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable)
