Step 1. Go to

Step 3. Select your desired subject.

Next to course career, select “undergraduate.”

Leave course attribute, course attribute value, and requirement designation blank.

Uncheck box next to “show open classes open” if you want to see all the classes that are offered (sometimes you can request an overtally for a fully enrolled class if you are a graduating senior, for example.).

Next to session, select “regular academic session” if viewing fall or spring schedules. If you are looking at summer, you may need to select the following to see courses: for extended schedule, select “eight week-first. For summer 1, select “four week –first.” For summer 2, select “four week – second.” For summer 3, select “three week.”

Leave mode of instruction blank to view all modes of instruction.

If you want particular times, click arrow next to “additional search criteria.”

Hit “SEARCH” button.

Step 6. To see class description (if available), click blue underlined area. This will show you more information, including class location, meeting dates, number of credits (called units), mode of instruction, how many seats are available, etc. The one item that might be missing is whether the course is cross-listed with another department or program. For example, this course is cross-listed with International Studies, but it is not displayed in this search. (CUNYfirst will show this information.)
