B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

- Completion of the A.A Degree in Political Science from Borough of Manhattan Community College (CUNY)

Transfer of Credit from **Borough of Manhattan Community College** to the **City College of New York**

- Graduates of **Borough of Manhattan Community College** with the associate degree in **Political Science** who select the courses specified in this articulation agreement will receive **60** contributory transfer credits toward the **CCNY Bachelor of Arts in Political Science** and **up to 15 credits toward the major requirements**.
- In addition, they will be deemed to have met all Required Core and Flexible Core Pathways requirements at City College.

Total additional credits required at the senior college to complete baccalaureate degree: **60**

Total credits required to earn the **Bachelor of Arts in Political Science**: **120**

C. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

PURPOSE: City College and Borough of Manhattan Community College hereby enter into this agreement to facilitate the opportunity for students who wish to transfer from Borough of Manhattan Community College's Associate's Degree in Political Science to City College Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science. Sections A and B of this agreement specify the conditions and requirements for admittance to City College. Sections H and I are listed as appendices and contain a Four-Year Advising Plan and selected course to course equivalencies between the Political Science program at Borough of Manhattan Community College, CUNY and the Political Science program at City College.

CHANGES: Neither party may change this agreement unilaterally. Proposed changes in policies and curricula (i.e. admission, curriculum, and degree requirements, course numbers, course content, and/or catalog descriptions by either party), must be communicated in writing to the other party, and jointly agreed upon in consultation with the relevant officials of each institution. Any changes agreed-upon must be signed, dated, and attached to this original agreement. *It is highly recommended that the department chairs the respective college programs jointly complete sections A, B, D, E, F of this agreement at least every two years.*

D. TRANSFER CREDITS AWARDED

Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) graduates who complete the Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree in Political Science will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Political Science from City College (CCNY)

G. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES.*1. Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:*

When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments, selected by their Chairpersons.

2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

Each semester, City College will provide BMCC with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled and; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.

3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.:

This articulation agreement will be published on the BMCC website and the City College website. Transfer advisors at BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.


4. Campus Updates to Transfer Credit Rules:


