This requirement applies whether you are a new student, transfer student from another U.S. university, or a student transferring between CUNY colleges.

SPONSOR SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

A sponsor must show sufficient financial resources to assure that the student being sponsored will not become a public charge (receive Federal or State low-income benefits or services) while in the United States. Evidence should consist of copies of any or all of the following documentation listed below that are applicable to the sponsor's situation. Failure to provide evidence of sufficient income and/or financial resources may result in the denial from the CUNY campus of the students' application for Form I-20 (Immigration Certificate of Eligibility). Additionally, such failure to provide similar documentation to the Consul Officer may result in denial of an F-1 Visa application.

* Please note that we only accept statements pertinent to liquid, low risk accounts as proof of financial support. Accounts such as retirement savings accounts and stock, no matter how stable the investment, will not be accepted as evidence of financial support.

Upon receipt of the above-mentioned documents your SEVIS Form I-20 will be processed after your previous school releases your record to us. Please note that a SEVIS Form I-20 may not be issued prior to the release date on the transfer form.

Once you have your SEVIS I-20, be sure to register FULL TIME.

Bachelor's (undergraduate) Students

Undergraduate tuition/fee per academic year, two semesters: Four-Year Colleges \$15,290*

*Undergraduate Tuition and Fees stated are based on the students taking at least 12 credits per semester. This is the minimum number of credits required to be a full-time undergraduate student (necessary to maintain lawful immigration status). If you take more than 12 credits, you will be charged at the rate of \$620 per credit (four year colleges).
