B.A. IN BLACK STUDIES M.A. IN THE STUDY OF THE AMERICAS

The Accelerated M.A. in the Study of the Americas allows talented and motivated undergraduate students in the B.A. in Black Studies to take up to 12 graduate credits and have these credits count toward both their B.A. and M.A. degrees. This enables them to finish their M.A. degree in just one year after completing their B.A.
