

### **New York State Residency Guidelines**

To be eligible for New York State tuition and fees, you may be required to prove NYS residency for at least a twelve-month period (1 year) effective the first day of class. If there is a question regarding your NYS residency and you wish to be charged in-state rates, you must complete a CUNY Residency Form. Failure to provide the required documentation(s) will result in you being billed as a non-resident.

**New York State Residency in Brief** - In general, to qualify for the resident tuition rate at a senior college based on residence in the State of New York, a student must:

- Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident or in a qualifying immigration status; AND
- Have continuously maintained his/her principal place of abode in NYS for a period of at least twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the first day of classes; AND
- Have a bona fide intention of living in New York permanently

#### Qualifying for Resident Tuition based on Attendance/Graduation from a NY High School:

Students, other than those in lawful non-immigration statuses, qualify for the resident tuition rate if they attended a New York high school for two or more years and graduated, or received a GED, and applied to attend CUNY within five years. This includes undocumented and out-of-state students.

<u>Dependent Students</u>: Generally, a dependent student's state of residency is considered the same as that of his or her custodial parent(s) or legal guardian(s). Students aged 24 and older are considered independent and are not deemed to have the same state of residency as their parent(s) or legal guardian(s).

<u>CUNY Transfers</u>: Students who previously attended a CUNY college and were charged the in-state/city tuition do not automatically qualify for in-state/city tuition at City College, and may be required to submit a residency form along with appropriate documentation.

**Submitting the Residency Form:** Fill out Part A and Part C of the residency form, and submit applicable documents in order to confirm (1) a qualifying immigration status and (2) residency in the state of New York. New students should submit documents to the <u>Office of Admissions</u>. Continuing City College students should submit documents to the <u>Office of the Registrar</u>. Both offices are located in the Wille Administration Building on the first floor.

#### To confirm a qualifying immigration status, submit one of the following:

- 1. If you are a US Citizen or Permanent Resident:
  - a. Proof of Citizenship (such as a passport of birth certificate)
  - b. Permanent Resident (green) card; or
  - c. Copy of I-551 stamp
- 2. If you are undocumented:
  - a. A NYS high school transcript indicating that you attended for at least two years and graduated; or
  - b. A copy of a NYS GED; and
  - c. A notarized affidavit of Intent to Legalize (Part B of this Residency Form)
- 3. If you are filing for Permanent Residence or Citizenship:
  - a. Official Government receipt of application (I-485 or I-797 form); or
  - b. work authorization card

- 4. For other eligible statuses, visit <u>The CUNY Residency Manual</u> for a list of acceptable documents
- 5. Students in the following lawful non-immigrant statuses are <u>not eligible</u> for the resident rate of tuition: B, C, D, F, H2, H3, H4 (family of H2 or H3), J, M, P, Q and TN.

#### To confirm New York State residency, submit two of the following items:

Students who qualify for the resident tuition rate based on <u>having attended and graduated from a NY</u> <u>high school or having received a GED (or TASC)</u> in NYS do not need to submit proof of NYS residency.

a. Copies of the most recent complete Federal and New York State tax returns.

b. A valid New York State driver's license or a "non-driver license" issued by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles with the student's name, with the date of issuance at least one year prior to the first day of classes,

c. Lease, deed or rent registration form (used for rent stabilized apartments) signed by the issuing authority, which is either a public or private agency, and the student or parent of the student with the same surname,

d. Homeowner's or renter's insurance policy with the student's name listed as insured,

e. Automobile registration with the student's name listed,

f. Automobile insurance certificate with the student's name listed as insured,

g. Voter registration certificate or card with the student's name, and date of registration

h. Bills for telephone, utility, cable TV or other home services, in the student's name, or other evidence of telephone, utility, cable TV or other home services provided to the student covering a period of 12 months,

i. Monthly bank or credit card statements, with the student's name, covering a period of 12 months (dollar amounts may be blocked out),

j. Attendance as a juror in New York State with the student's name,

k. Housing lease signed by the landlord (who is an individual and is not a public or private agency) and the student. If the student's name does not appear on the lease, the "Alternate Lease Statement" may be substituted. The "Alternate Lease Statement" must be completed and notarized by both the person whose name appears on the lease/contract and the student. The person whose name appears on the lease/contract must also submit proof (i.e., lease, telephone, utility, or similar type bills) of residency at his/her current address for the previous 12 months,

I. Postmarked mail addressed to a student at a New York address at least 12 months immediately preceding the first day of classes (a P.O Box is not acceptable),

m. Letter showing eligibility or disbursement of Social Security or New York City Public Assistance with the student's New York address covering the 12-month period immediately preceding the first day of classes and including the student's name,

n. IDNYC New York City municipal identification card, showing the date of issuance at least one year prior to the first day of classes

If you answered "yes" to question 4 or 5, and to question 6, and are a resident of another state, you do not need to complete any other sections of this form. If you answered "yes" to question 7, you do not need to complete any other sections of this form. All other students must complete Part C of this form and submit appropriate supporting documentation.

Please note that some students who are here on visas may not be eligible for the resident tuition rate. Please refer to the CUNY Tuition and Fee Manual (see link below) for a comprehensive list of eligible visa types.

### To Be Completed by All Students

I certify that all information provided and all statements made in all sections of this Residency Form are true and correct to the best of my knowledge.

I understand that if I provide false information or withhold relevant information in order to obtain resident status, The City University may revoke its determination of in-state residency, and that I will owe non-resident tuition to the University for each semester or session that I have attended under these circumstances. I also understand that I may be subject to disciplinary action.
