- For a **minor** in French and Francophone Cultures a student must complete **15** credits of advanced courses (usually accumulated as 5 three-credit courses at the 300-level and/or 400-level).
- For a **major** in French and Francophone Cultures a student must complete **36** credits of advanced courses (usually accumulated as 12 three-credit courses at the 300-level and 400-level). A minimum of **27** credits must be taken from the list below. A total of **9** credits from relevant courses in other disciplines may be considered to count towards the major *subject to approval from an adviser in the French program*.
- Credits acquired as part of summer or semester-long study abroad in a Francophone country may also be considered to count toward the minor or major through consultation with an adviser.

PREREQUISITES : The prerequisite for all 300- and 400-level French courses is French 22600, four years of high school preparation or placement by examination.

300-LEVEL COURSES. When taught by different instructors, each of these courses may be taken up to two times for credit.
