RULES & REGULATIONS FOR INTERFAITH COUNCIL MEETINGS

- 1. All confirmed Council members are expected and required to be in attendance for all Council meetings. If there are any club representatives unable to attend, they are required to reach out to a USG council member 24 hours in advance.
- 2. Any clubs that wish to join or be removed from the Council must reach out to a USG council member or the Vice President of Student Affairs.
- Council meetings are co-chaired by the USG President, additional USG member, and Vice President of Student Affairs. You must be acknowledged by the chair before speaking.
- 4. Quorum is $\frac{2}{3}$ of the Council. Quorum must be met in order for voting to take place. Votes are passed if at least $\frac{2}{3}$ of the voting members vote "yes."
- 5. Interfaith Council meetings are open to the public. However, public audience members are there as viewers and will not be allowed to participate in any voting or discussions, unless directly acknowledged by the chair. Audience members shall refrain from loud commentary and disruptions.
- 6. Agendas are drafted and finalized prior to the Council convening. All Council members are reached out to in advance and encouraged to provide any agenda items they have in mind.
- 7. All other rules are outlined in the Interfaith Resolution. Any feedback, suggestions, or changes shall be communicated with the USG President or the Vice President of Student Affairs.
