New! How to sign up for those secret AIP classes

Well, maybe the classes aren't exactly *secret*. But they are very interesting and a little hard to find.

Our department – Anthropology and Interdisciplinary Programs – is now using a new system for listing many of our classes. These classes are listed under "bucket" titles like **WS 39100: Advanced Topics in Women's and Gender Studies.** Underneath this title and course number, you can find four actual classes:

WS 39100 – 19903, Post Trauma Recovery
WS 39100 – 24483, Disaster Capitalism and Creative Community Resistance
WS 39100 – 24486, The Monstrous Body: Blackness, Power, and Representation
WS 39100 – 38136, LGBTQ World History

You can take one or more of these classes in the same semester. And you can take one of these classes this semester and then take another one of the classes in a future semester. (You can take classes with the WS 39100 number up to *ten times* while you are an undergrad here.)

The "bucket titles" usually have names like "Special Topics" or "Advanced Topics." If you see a name like this, then you know that one or more specific courses are hidden underneath it. And you have to go looking!

For some course numbers, like WS 39100, there is actually more than one class underneath that number. Si you need to make sure that you **click on the box underneath the course title** and choose one of the five-digit numbers. (The box is highlighted in red below.) That way, you can see exactly the class that you want.

Some people find it easier to look up classes in CUNY Global Search, https://globalsearch.cuny.edu/

There, you can see the information about each class. Make sure to click on the arrow next to the course number so that you can see all of the different classes listed for that course number. (The arrow is highlighted in red in this picture.)

Then click on the "Section" title and you can see the full course description.

Once you've found the classes you like in CUNY Global Search, you can hopefully go to Schedule Builder ... and register for them !
