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Dean Mercado's Welcome Message

Every summer, CPS releases a catalog for those who want to take advantage of our offerings between the busy Fall and Spring academic semesters. Our commitment to excellence and innovation remains unwavering. Scholas' 2023 report on "The Future of Tech in America" showed that 98% of surveyed 650 C-suite executives, 100 hiring managers, and 1,500 office workers agreed that "tech skills are likely to be essential across every work sector in the next ten years." There is currently a lot of conversation about artificial intelligence (A.I.). To stay at the forefront of job market demands and academic innovation, we launched five A.I. courses in the Fall and Spring Semesters 2024/25 for adult workers and students who wanted to explore A.I.'s role in the workplace. These A.I. introductory courses are aligned with rapid changes in the health care, technology, and cybersecurity sectors. In Spring 2025, we returned with CISCO Cyber Ops, CompTIA A+, and Google IT Support courses.

Our Allied Health program launched a grant from the Department of Labor (DOL) to offer several courses such as Certified Clinical Medical Assistant, Medical Interpreter, EKG and Phlebotomy Technician for free to underemployed and unemployed individuals. The grant allowed our students to receive training at no cost with all materials included and enhance career prospects. We are partnered with Northwell Hospital (Northwell Flexstaff) to make available externships to our Certified Clinical Medical Assistant students and graduates.



Our commitment to advancing workers is evident in our expansion of course offerings in key areas such as healthcare, information technology, workforce-based ESOL and GED programs, and our English Language Institute (ELI) for aspiring college students. In Spring 2025, we expanded ELI from our CCNY West Harlem campus to Wall Street, where international students and NYC residents learned intensive English while taking advantage of the many learning opportunities downtown. While our ELI students choose CCNY for its excellent intensive English programming, they also recognize that New York City is the best city in the world to learn English.

This summer, CPS will launch a new three-year grant from NYC Small Business Services (SBS) to help immigrant restaurant workers improve their English in the workplace. In 2024, our new CPS Director, Bino Realuyo, a lead grant writer, partnered with Paul Shively, Director of CLIP at BMCC, and was awarded a Vocational English as a Second Language (VESL) grant. They will collaborate with restaurant employers to provide 150 limited English proficient food service workers with on-site and remote English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) classes. Our new funding includes curriculum development, program delivery, wrap-around supportive services, and an opportunity to elevate the economic lives of one of the most overlooked segments of our working population.

How to Register

Our certificate programs are designed to equip adults with the appropriate level of skills in the least amount of time possible to prepare them for the workforce. **Most programs require at least a high school or HSE diploma for admittance.** Please review the specific certificate program prerequisites and REGISTER ONLINE>

Our catalog has QR codes that link to our CPS website and course pages.

You must have an account with us in order to register. Please visit our website <u>ccny.cuny.edu/cps</u> and click <u>Registration</u> in the menu. Once in our registration page, click "Create Account" to create an account on our system that will allow you to register and add courses to your cart. Now you're ready to checkout!

Enrollment Requirement

CPS courses are accessible and open to the public. They are available in various formats and modalities: in-person, hybrid, online synchronous (e.g. in real time on Zoom), and online asynchronous (e.g. discussion boards). This flexibility allows our students to align their learning goals with their preferred learning mode. Enrollment at CCNY is not required to take our non-credit courses. However, a high school or HSE diploma is required to enroll in most of our certificate programs.

Payment Plans

Students can apply for a payment plan for open courses with a tuition cost of \$500 or more. A 50% of tuition deposit plus a non-refundable \$25 registration fee are required to enroll in a payment plan. An additional 10% fee will be charged to the tuition fee when selecting the payment plan option. Refund Policy

Refund requests must be submitted in writing via email at least five business days before the first day of class. A 100% refund, including the registration fee, will be issued if CPS cancels a course. If the student withdraws at least five business days before the first day of class, a 100% refund will be issued (less the \$25 registration fee). Refunds for one- or two-day workshops are only issued if the class is canceled. Be advised that non-attendance does not constitute a withdrawal or request for a refund. It is important to note that refunds are not issued after the first class session.

Refund requests are processed within approximately 6 to 8 weeks upon receipt and approval by CPS. Credit card refunds are credited to the card used for registration. Payments made by money orders and business checks are refunded via a mailed check.

Discounts

Senior citizens 60 years or older receive a discount of \$25 applied towards the \$25 registration fee for any open course costing \$99 or more (except computer courses). CCNY faculty, staff, students, and CCNY Alumni Association members receive a 10% course discount (exclusions may apply). A 10% discount on tuition is also available when your referral registers for a course of equal or greater value. Once eligible, you must present a valid ID confirming your current CCNY affiliation. Discounts cannot be combined with any other offers.

Course Date Changes & Course Cancellations

CPS courses are subject to a minimum enrollment. We reserve the right to cancel any class that does not meet the minimum registration required. If a course is canceled, students will receive a full refund. All course dates are subject to change as deemed necessary by CPS.

Classroom Location

Students enrolled in on-campus classes will receive an email with classroom information within one week of the course start date.

Incomplete (INC) Grades Policy

The grade of "INC" (incomplete) is temporary and given by the instructor with the following guidelines:

When the student has been consistent with passing coursework, and the instructor acknowledges the student can successfully complete the course requirements by the last day of the eighth week, or its equivalent in calendar time, of the following semester. The student must provide an acceptable and documented reason for not completing the coursework on time.

If the student does not submit the coursework accordingly, the grade will change to an "F" (Fail), and the student will forfeit the possibility of changing the incomplete status. The "F" grade will be permanent on the student record unless the instructor has submitted a passing grade. CPS will convert temporary "INC" grades to "F" by the ninth week of the following semester.

Grants and Scholarships

Career Success Scholarship: The Helena Rubenstein Foundation has long supported Continuing Education students at CUNY who pursue career advancement through education and training. Students who need tuition assistance can apply for the Helena Rubenstein Career Success Scholarship, which is available to cover up to 90% of a certificate program's tuition fees. Scholarship availability is limited and decisions are made by the CUNY office. Application begins on October 2024 for the Spring 2025 semester.

Free GED/ESOL Courses: Since 1985, the CPS grant-funded Adult Education Program has served adult learners by providing tuition-free classes that prepare its students to gain access to higher education, pursue post-secondary training, and build their knowledge base to secure employment and achieve financial independence. These program efforts continue to strengthen the Harlem community and the greater New York area.

We offer General Education Development (GED) preparation classes for students to obtain a High School Equivalency (HSE) Diploma, and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) courses that help non-English speakers achieve competency in reading, writing, speaking, and comprehension of the English Language. Additionally, students receive college and career advisement, and job readiness and job placement assistance. The classes are available in the morning and evening on weekdays. Students must first attend an orientation and take a placement test before registration. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Please complete the waiting list form below:

Pharmacy Technician



This 75-Hour Course prepares students with practical knowledge for employment across various healthcare establishments, including community and chain pharmacies/hospitals, as well as readiness for the National certification exam through PTCB.

For over a decade, this course has provided high completion rates and individuals with a PTCB-approved certification. Preparing people for the workforce with the necessary knowledge.

The curriculum covers topics such as anatomy and physiology, pharmacy law, medical terminology, Pharmacology, and the mathematical concepts required for the accurate preparation and dispensation of medicine.

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Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

This 130-hour certificate provides the necessary knowledge and skills to become a nationally certified nursing assistant.

Course topics include Anatomy and Physiology, Basic Life Support, and the Fundamentals of Patient Care. Students will learn how to assist patients with daily living tasks by providing primary care services, such as bedmaking, grooming, and measuring vital signs.

We are a NYS Education (NYSED) approved learning format, consisting of online synchronous classroom instruction and a 30-hour in-person clinical externship at a nursing facility. Students are assigned to a clinical externship in a nursing home during the program's final 4 to 6 weeks.

Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs) work under the supervision of a registered nurse (RN), licensed practical nurse (LPN), physician assistant (PA), nurse practitioner (NP), medical doctor, or other supervisory staff in a healthcare facility.

Students will learn how to draw blood from patients or donors, assemble equipment (such as needles, blood collection devices, gauze, tourniquets, cotton, and alcohol), obtain blood from capillaries, and will play a vital role in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases.

Electrocardiogram Technician (EKG)

Our HYBRID 60-Hour EKG Technician certificate program is perfect for CNAs and other patient care professionals who want to become Certified Patient Care Technicians (PCTs).

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Electrocardiography provides techniques for learning about basic cardiac physiology, identify heart problems, and how to perform 12-lead electrocardiograms (EKG), identify normal heart rhythm and arrhythmia, and troubleshoot technical issues with an EKG.

This EKG course prepares students to assist patients with Holter monitoring and stress testing under the supervision of medical professionals.

CASAC Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance abuse Counseler Substance abuse Counselor Training



In collaboration with the Psychology Department of the Colin Powell School for Civic Leadership at CCNY, we provide the NYS OASAScertified CASAC Training Program. This program offers ten (10) OASAS-approved courses that meet NYS 350 hours of education training required to obtain the CASAC-Trainee credential.

Topics include:

- The psychopharmacological and physiological aspects of drugs, signs, symptoms, and stages of alcoholism, individual and group counseling skills, the ethics of confidentiality, family treatment, and multicultural issues.
- The training will prepare you for a career in substance abuse counseling or enhance your skills as a social worker, psychologist, psychiatrist, rehabilitation counselor, mental health counselor, substance abuse counselor, marriage and family therapist, or school counselor.

CASAC Credential Information:

Completion of 350 hours of education/training, supervised-practical training, documented work experience, and passing the NYS-OASAS written examination are required for the CASAC designation. 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English Classes and GED Preparation

We are funded by the NYS Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) which allows us to offer adult education classes tuition-free. In order to participate, adult students must be: (1) 19 years old or older, (2) a NYS resident, and (3) available for employment.

Our GED Preparation classes prepare students to pass the GED (General Educational Development) Exam leading to a High School Equivalency (HSE) Diploma as well as building students skills for success in college and the workplace. We are a combined workforce and ESOL program funded by the New York State WIOA program. The program helps non-native English speakers develop proficiency in grammar, reading, listening, speaking and writing skills as well as building students skills for success in the workplace.

Due to high volume of applicants, both courses are on waitlist applications. These are on a first come, first served basis. We have a waiting list for both classes: <u>English Class waiting list</u> and <u>GED Waiting List</u>

Traditional Techniques in Graphic Storytelling



This comprehensive course delves into the art of graphic storytelling, emphasizing traditional drawing techniques while allowing participants the flexibility to use either iPads (tablets), smartphones or sketchbooks as preferred tools. Students will learn the foundational principles of storytelling, character design, and scene composition. The course integrates hands-on practice, encouraging students to explore traditional and modern tools to refine their storytelling and artistic skills.

Taught by 2021 Emmy award recipient Dario Bolivar; a digital artist, animator, and motion graphic designer known for his works in film festivals across the country and founder of <u>Dariobol</u>.

Learning Objectives:

- Master traditional drawing techniques for comics and graphic novels.
- Empower old-school methodologies and the use of traditional media such as pencils and paper.
- Utilize sketchbooks or iPads effectively for brainstorming and storyboarding.
- Explore free and professional design software for enhancing illustrations.
- Draw inspiration from and relate the content of comics and cinema for enriched storytelling.
- Create a short, 6-page graphic novel combining traditional and digital techniques.

By the end of the course, students will produce a fully realized 6-page graphic novel that showcases their mastery of traditional and modern storytelling techniques. This project will reflect their creative interpretation and visual narrative skills.

Architecture Summer Career Lab

Hosted at New York City's flagship public school of architecture, this 4-week Summer Career Lab introduces architectural practice, theory, making, and thinking to those considering career in the field. Within a state-of-the-art facility and taught by faculty from the Spitzer School's NAAB- accredited degree programs, the Summer Career Lab will be organized around a diverse set of events and exercises including:

- Lectures on architectural fundamentals
- Workshops on drawing and making
- One-on-one critiques and collective pin-up reviews
- Field trips and on-site work across the city, including in City College's historic Manhattanville and Hamilton Heights
- Presentations from award-winning architects, historians, and designers

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Security Guard Certifications

8-Hour Pre-Assignment Training for Security Guards

This 8-hour course is the first step in obtaining a security guard registration card from the New York State Department of State. The course curriculum provides students with a general overview of the duties and responsibilities of a security guard. Topics covered in this course include the role of the security guard, legal powers and limitations, emergencies, communications and public relations, access control, and ethics and conduct. The passing of an examination is required for the successful completion of this course.

The passing of an examination is required for the successful completion of this course.

Foundation of Supply Chain Management



This program teaches students the fundamentals of supply chain management, preparing individuals with prior experience for entry-level positions in supply chain. This is a collaboration between the Association of Supply Chain Management (ACSM) and TADACA Educational Solutions, LLC. It is taught by an APICS Certified Instructor.

The Modules Include:




