- Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement: When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments, selected by their chairpersons/program director.
- Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:
   Each semester, The City College of New York will provide Hostos with the following information: a) the number of Hostos students who applied to the program; b) the number of Hostos students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of Hostos students who enrolled and; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.
- Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.:
   This articulation agreement will be publicized on the Hostos website and The City College of New York website. Transfer advisors at Hostos will promote this agreement with eligible students.
