

## Tuition Discount

- Seniors (60 years or older): Registration waived (\$25 value) for courses costing \$99 or more (except computer courses).
- CCNY students, staff, and Alumni Association members receive 10% off with valid ID card.
- 10% discount is available when your referral registers for a course of equal or greater value.

**Note:** Only one discount applies. Cannot be combined.

## Payment Plans

Students may apply for a payment plan for open courses with a tuition cost of \$500 or more. To enroll, a deposit of 50% of the tuition plus a non-refundable \$25 registration fee is required. An additional 10% service fee will be added to the tuition when selecting the payment plan option. ## Enrollment Requirement

CPS courses are open to the public and designed for accessibility. They are offered in a variety of formats, including in-person, hybrid, online synchronous (e.g., live sessions via Zoom), and online asynchronous (e.g., discussion boards and self-paced activities). This flexible approach allows students to choose the learning mode that best fits their goals and schedule. Enrollment at CCNY is not required to take our non-credit courses. Students must have a high school diploma or high school Equivalency (HSE), be at least 18 years of age, and able to work legally in the U.S. Please check individual courses for additional eligibility requirements.

## Classroom Location

Students enrolled in on-campus classes will receive an email with classroom details approximately one week before the course start date.

## Refund Policy

Refund requests must be submitted in writing via email at least five business days prior to the first day of class. If a course is canceled by CPS, a 100% refund, including the registration fee, will be issued. If a student withdraws at least five business days before the first class, a 100% refund will be issued, minus the \$25 non-refundable registration fee. **No refunds will be issued after the first class session.** Refunds for one- or two-day workshops are only provided if the class is canceled by CPS. Please note that non-attendance or dissatisfaction with the class do not constitute an official withdrawal or refund request.

Refunds are processed within approximately 6 to 8 weeks after receipt and approval by CPS. Credit card payments will be refunded to the original card used, while payments made by money order or business check will be refunded via mailed check. ## Incomplete (INC) Grades Policy

The grade of "INC" (Incomplete) is a temporary grade assigned by the instructor under the following conditions:

The student must have maintained satisfactory progress in the course and demonstrated the potential to successfully complete the remaining coursework. Additionally, the student must provide a valid, documented reason for not completing the course requirements on time. The outstanding work must be completed by the last day of the eighth week (or its calendar equivalent) of the following semester.

If the required coursework is not submitted within this timeframe, the "INC" grade will automatically convert to an "F" (Fail), and the student will forfeit the opportunity to change the incomplete status. The "F" will remain on the student's permanent record unless the instructor submits a passing grade prior to the deadline. CPS will process the conversion of all unresolved "INC" grades to "F" beginning the ninth week of the following semester.

## Course Cancellations & Date Changes

CPS courses are subject to minimum enrollment requirements. We reserve the right to cancel any class that does not meet the required minimum registration. In the event of a course cancellation, students will receive a full refund. Please note that all course dates are subject to change at the discretion of CPS.

# Directions to the City College Campus

## By Train:

Take the IRT #1 local to 137th Street and Broadway. Walk up 138th Street three blocks to Convent Avenue.

Take the IND "A" or "D" express or "B" or "C" local to 145th Street and St. Nicholas Avenue, walk west one block to 145th Street and Convent Avenue, then south to 138th Street. The CCNY shuttle bus makes regular stops to this subway during the day. Take the IRT #4 or #5 express or #6 local to 125th Street and Lexington Avenue. Change there for the M-100 or M-101 bus to Amsterdam Avenue and 138th Street. Walk east one block to Convent Avenue.

Take the Metro North to 125th Street and Park Avenue. Change there for the M-100 or M-101 bus to Amsterdam Avenue and 138th Street, walk east one block to Convent Avenue.

## By Bus:

Take the M-4 or M-5 to Broadway and 137th Street. Walk up 138th Street three blocks to Convent Avenue.

Take the M-100 or M-101 to Amsterdam Avenue and 138th Street, walk east one block to Convent Avenue.

Take the M-101 to 135th Street and Amsterdam Avenue and walk north to 138th Street, then east one block to Convent Avenue.

Take the BX-19 to 145th Street and Convent Avenue, walk south on Convent Avenue to 138th Street.

## By Car:

From the West Side Highway: Exit at 125th Street. Cross Broadway and turn left onto Amsterdam Avenue. The College is at 138th Street and Amsterdam Avenue.

From the East Side: Take the FDR or the RFK (Triborough) Bridge to Harlem River Drive. Exit at 135th Street. Continue to St. Nicholas Avenue and turn right, then left onto 141st Street. Turn left onto Convent Avenue. The campus begins at 140th Street and Convent Avenue.

## Upcoming Courses: Job Training & Continuing Education

### Professional Drone Operations

Develop skills in drone flight, safety, and data analysis in this hands-on course. Learn to collect and process aerial imagery using tools like QGIS, Meshroom, and Agisoft—ideal for construction, environmental monitoring, and agriculture careers.

### GPRO Fundamentals of Building Green

Introductory 4-hour course on green building principles, energy use, and high performance construction—ideal for real estate, construction, facilities & related fields.

### HAZWOPER 40-hour Certification

Certification training in hazardous waste operations and emergency response—required for many jobs involving contaminated sites, cleanup, or environmental work.

### OSHA 30-hour Construction

Essential safety training for anyone entering or working in construction. This intro-level course provides the OSHA 30 card—required on most job sites.

### NYC Site Safety Training (SST 10-Hour)

Required by the NYC Department of Buildings for most construction jobs in the city, Covers essential safety topics and complements OSHA 30.

### AutoCAD Essentials

Learn to draft, edit, and interpret real construction drawings in this hands-on 24-hour course. Perfect for both beginners and working pros who want practical skills they can use on the job.

### Revit Architecture Essentials

Introductory 3-day course covers core concepts, including 3D architectural modeling and BIM construction documentation. Ideal for those in architecture, design and construction.

### Civil 3D Essentials

Intensive 3-day introduction to civil design software used for infrastructure projects—including roads, sites, and utilities. Ideal for engineers, surveyors, planners and CAD professionals

### Fusion Essentials

Foundational 3-day course introduces parametric modeling and covers 2D sketching, 3D modeling, assemblies, T-splines, and design analysis.



## Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program

This 130-hour hybrid course equips students with the training and knowledge required to take the New York State Nurse Aide Exam.



Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs) benefit from the increase in longevity and changes in the health care system. This has created an increased need for educated and skilled CNAs. The CNA profession is ideal for people seeking work in nursing homes, hospitals, doctors' offices and health care facilities.

The CNA Program includes: Anatomy and Physiology, Basic Life Support, and the Fundamentals of Patient Care. Students will learn how to assist patients with daily living tasks by providing primary care services, such as bedmaking, grooming, and measuring vital signs.

We are a NYS Education (NYSED) approved learning format, consisting of online synchronous classroom instruction and a 30-hour in-person clinical training at a nursing facility. Students are assigned to a clinical externship in a nursing home during the program's final 4 to 6 weeks. Clinicals are always scheduled on weekends.

CNAs work under the supervision of a registered nurse (RN), licensed practical nurse (LPN), physician assistant (PA), nurse practitioner (NP), medical doctor, or other supervisory staff in a healthcare facility.

## Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA)

320-hour hybrid course meeting NYS training requirements for multi-skilled medical assistants.



The Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) Certificate Program is designed to prepare students for a career as a multi-skilled allied health professional, capable of performing both administrative and clinical duties in healthcare settings such as medical offices, clinics, and outpatient centers.

Students will learn to schedule appointments, manage electronic health records, perform billing and coding tasks, and support business operations. Clinical instruction includes taking and recording vital signs, preparing patients for examinations, drawing blood specimens, administering medications as directed by a physician, and conducting EKG testing.

Topics include medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, clinical procedures, EKG and phlebotomy, CPR, vital signs, business practices, and job readiness. Two hours of class time will be dedicated to developing effective study skills for success in the classroom and the field.

## Phlebotomy Technician Certificate

In this introductory hybrid course, students will learn the skills of a Phlebotomy Technician. This course includes a combination of theory and practical training.

### Topics include:

- Standard precautions
- Collecting blood specimens
- Diagnosis and treatment
- Performing capillary punctures

Live venipunctures, conducted in class, will be a component of this course, including drawing blood on classmates and having your own blood drawn.

Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to take the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Certification exam. NHA exam fee is not included in tuition.

## Electrocardiogram Technician (EKG)



Electrocardiogram (ECG/EKG) Technicians prepare patients for testing on ECG machines and Holter monitors. The technician takes the patient history and administers the actual ECGs for physicians to interpret.

Upon completion, the students will be eligible to take the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Certification Exam. NHA exam fee is not included in tuition. Textbooks are not included in tuition.




