



Fall 2026 Transfer Student Advising

All advising appointments are created through Navigate Student. This platform will give you powerful planning tools and quick access to valuable information. Visit the [CCNY Navigate Student website](#) for more information.

1. Download the Navigate Student mobile app from the [Apple App Store](#) or from [Google Play](#). Search for "Navigate Student." The platform can also be accessed [here](#).
2. Log in to Navigate using your CUNY login credentials ([First.Last##@login.cuny.edu](#)).
 - a. Note: If you use the Navigate Student app at your current school, you will need to log out of the app and use the "Change Schools" link at the bottom of the logout page to select City College.
3. Go to "Appointments" and then "Schedule an Appointment."
4. Select your appointment type: "Academic Advising."
5. Select "New Transfer Academic Planning", and pick a date after April 14th.
6. Click on the "Find Available Times" button and choose a date and time.
7. Select a meeting type (In-person, Virtual, Phone, etc.) by using the drop-down menu in the "How would you like to meet?" field. (This field is towards the bottom of the page/screen.)
8. Please review the information on the confirmation page, especially the "Details" section. You may be asked to provide information in the "Would you like to share anything else" box. Provide a mobile number if you would like to receive a text reminder of your appointment.
9. Click on the blue "Schedule" button to finalize your appointment. You'll receive confirmation of your appointment to your City College email address.

Your Advising Office: Your admitted major determines your Advising Office. See below table for information about which Advising Office houses your major.

- If you have been admitted to the Grove School of Engineering, select the new transfer advising service for your major.

Changing Your Major: Select 'New Transfer Major Change' and schedule an appointment with the Advising Office that houses your new intended major.

- If you are changing to undecided choose "New Transfer Academic Planning" with The Hub.
- Note: You cannot change your major to engineering, computer science or architecture unless you have been admitted to that professional school first. If this is your intention, select "New Transfer Academic Planning" with The Hub.

Registration begins on Tuesday, April 14th. Schedule your advisement appointment as soon as possible in order to register for classes.



Advisement at The City College of New York

Advisement at City College is housed within the school or division to which you have been admitted. Use the chart below to determine where you'll be advised. Note that if you hope to be admitted to The Grove School of Engineering or The Bernard and Anne Spitzer School of Architecture, but have not met the requirements for entry yet, you will be advised by **The Hub**.
