Learning outcomes

A student will:

- Gather, interpret, and assess information from a variety of sources and points of view.
- Evaluate evidence and arguments critically or analytically.
- Communicate effectively and confidently, producing well-reasoned arguments using evidence to support conclusions.
- Utilize analytic and/or philosophical reasoning, sometimes in conjunction with case studies, to examine fundamental questions of ethics, justice and epistemology.
- Demonstrate proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing in a language other than English.
- Understand cultural characteristics, historical contexts, and social aspects of areas where the language is spoken, fostering an appreciation for other cultures.
