### **Requirements for Admission to Bilingual Childhood Education Stream C:**

- Possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Demonstrate the ability to pursue graduate study successfully. Candidates should possess a grade point average of B (3.0) or above in prior undergraduate and graduate work.
- Submit GRE score.
- Submit three letters of recommendation.
- Demonstrate liberal arts and sciences preparation in the areas of artistic expression; communication; information retrieval; concepts in history and social sciences; humanities; scientific and mathematical processes; and written expression.
- Be successfully interviewed by a program advisor.
- Successfully complete on-site essay in English and the additional language
