Requirements for Admission to Bilingual Extension:

- Possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Hold New York State Initial, Professional, or Permanent Teaching Certification (in any area except English Language Arts, World Languages and TESOL).
- Demonstrate the ability to pursue graduate study successfully. Candidates should possess a grade point average of B (3.0) or above in prior undergraduate and graduate work.
- Submit GRE score.
- Submit three letters of recommendation.
- Successfully complete on-site essay in a language other than English.
- Be successfully interviewed by a program advisor.
