- Possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Demonstrate the ability to pursue graduate study successfully. Students should possess a grade point average of B (3.0) or above in prior undergraduate and graduate coursework.
- Submit three letters of recommendation.
- Submit GRE scores.
- Demonstrate liberal arts and sciences preparation in the areas of artistic expression; communication; information retrieval; concepts in history and social sciences; humanities; scientific and mathematical processes; and written expression.
- Be successfully interviewed by a program advisor.
- Successfully complete on-site essay.
