Requirements for Admission to TESOL Stream D:

- Hold a New York State Teaching Certificate, and submit a copy of that certificate as part of the admissions process.
- Possess a master's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Submit GRE Scores.
- Demonstrate the ability to pursue graduate study successfully. Students should possess a grade point average of B (3.0) or above in prior undergraduate and graduate work.
- Submit three letters of recommendation.
- Be successfully interviewed by a program advisor.
- Successfully complete on-site essay.
