1. Complete the attached Non-Degree application and obtain approval from the appropriate faculty advisor. (The application can be completed online, but must be printed out and submitted to the Office of Graduate Admissions after a faculty advisor has approved your application. The application **must** be accompanied by a proof of bachelor's degree).
2. Submit your completed Non-Degree Application to the appropriate Office of Graduate Admissions (see above) and pay the \$125 non-refundable application fee. (The application fee can only be paid by check, money order, or cash). If paying cash, please pay at the Bursar's window.
3. See your faculty advisor on the day assigned for new non-degree students to have your course(s) approved and your registration entered into the system, (Check the CCNY website at www.ccny.cuny.edu/registrar for the registration schedule).
4. Pick up your bill and pay by the date noted on the lower left-hand portion of your bill. This may be done in person at the Bursar's Office (A-103) or online. Online bills will be available approximately 24 hours after registering for courses. To access your bill online, log into the CUNY Portal and make payment using either MasterCard or Discover. Your PIN will be activated the day after registration. The PIN is your date of birth in the following format MMDDYY. **Please note that you must have your bill validated by the Bursar by the due date or you will be de-registered!**
5. Obtain a City College Identification Card. Once you have your bill, go to the ID Office (NAC 1/204) for your picture identification. It is mandatory to show your ID to the security guard when entering any CCNY buildings.
6. If you were born after Dec. 31, 1956 and are planning to register for six (6) or more credits, you must provide proof of immunization (measles, mumps, and rubella immunity) to the Wellness & Counseling Center (WCC) in Marshak Hall Room 115. You may also show proof of immunity by having a blood test (titer). Failure to follow this procedure will result in a delay in registration. Important Information

- As of February 1, 1999, Graduate Non-Degree students are limited to a maximum of 9 credits for the School of Education, 12 credits for the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and 6 credits for the School of Engineering while in attendance at CCNY. No exceptions or exemptions are granted beyond the maximum allowance. In order to continue beyond the maximum allowed credits, students must apply for matriculation.
- The School of Architecture, Computer Science MIS, Media Arts Production, Mental Health Counseling, and the Public Service Management programs do not permit non-degree students.
- Education students who are planning to matriculate must take the New York State Teacher Certification Examination (NYSTCE) of the Liberal Arts and Science Test (LAST) before completion of the 9 credit maximum as a non-degree student.
