3 p.m.) for an appointment and voucher. If you choose to use the vision benefit at a participating vision provider, call 212-815-1531 for a list of providers and a voucher.

The supplemental vision benefit (available 12 months after the standard vision benefit is used) is provided only at 115 Chambers St., and includes an eye examination and lens change, if necessary; call 212-766-4452 for appointment.

Legal Services

Municipal Employees Legal Services lawyers represent full-time employees and retirees on personal legal matters including wills, consumer problems, evictions, divorces,

wills, consumer problems, evictions, divorces, debt, bankruptcy, foreclosures, citizenship, governmental benefits, credit rating and public utility problems.

Full-time employees and retirees can also obtain assistance in buying a one- or two-family residence, selling a one-family residence and in certain Family Court matters.

Municipal Employees Housing Program

DC 37's Municipal Employees Housing Program provides one-stop afford-able housing services for city employees. MEHP is a partnership of the union, Neighborhood Housing Services, and the NYC Dept. of Housing Preservation and Development.

Through MEHP, city employees have a 5 percent preference for HPD rental apartments, which are available through lottery. MEHP works with 10 banks to get the best mortgage rates and can get HomeFirst grants of up to \$15,000 toward down payment or closing costs.

MEHP provides counseling and more to help members buy co-ops, condos, or houses within the five boroughs. Call 212-815-1814 to speak to a program representative.

The card offers 100% fraud protection if your card is lost or stolen and all calls are answered in the United States 24 hours a day.

The card is issued by the Household Bank (Nevada) N.A. If you apply and there is no response within four weeks, call the bank toll-free at 800-651-5108 to check on the status of your application.
