Free and confidential primary health care by professional medical personnel. Includes physical exams, immunizations, over-the-counter medication, GYN services, pregnancy testing, contraception education, blood tests, STD screenings, smoking cessation coaching, nutrition education, information about health insurance options, a peer health educator program, and other services. Most services are free; some lab services have a student-rate fee. Provides free-of-charge, short-term individual counseling for depression, family/relationship issues, stress and time management, sexual orientation, cultural adjustment, drug and alcohol abuse, and other coping issues. Refers students needing longer-term services to low-cost or free community partners. Provides early childhood care and education to children of CCNY students. Children must be two years of age and toilet trained. The daytime program costs \$75 per week and runs 7:45am – 5:30pm Monday through Friday. The evening program has a pro-rated fee and runs 4:00pm – 9:00pm Monday through Thursday.
