Your comments can be anonymous if you wish, or you may include your email address which the committee(s) will use only to ask additional questions about your feedback or seek clarification.

Briefly, here are some other highlights within the site:

- **Upcoming Events** will include announcements of upcoming strategic planning discussions such as town hall meetings.
- **Milestones and Momentum** houses the strategic planning committees' preliminary report. This section will also be used to document achievements and measure our success in carrying out the plan objectives.
- **About the Process** contains the project charge, framework and timeline.
- The **Committees** tab displays each committee's charge, membership and meeting dates/times.
- **Resources** houses documents/reports that the committees had access to throughout the process to help inform their discussions.
- **FAQ** provides information on various topics such as initiative goals, providing feedback, etc.
- **News** is a repository of announcements and updates provided throughout the process.
- The **Feedback** tab provides the opportunity for you to submit input that will be distributed to the appropriate committee chair(s) to inform their respective committees.
