- The first time you visit, you must click on **Register**.




- After you click **Submit**, you will be brought back to the **Login Screen**. Log in using the information you just entered.

- Each assignment is timed. On the Sample Exams you will have 20 minutes to complete 5 problems. On the real final exam, you will have 100 minutes to complete all 25 problems.



- The picture below tells you about the various buttons you will need to use to move through the exam.

- Each question has 4 answer choices. They may not all fit on your screen. You must scroll to see them.


- When you are done with the *entire assignment*, click **Grade**. If you did not answer some of the questions, you will see a screen like the one below.


